## COMPOSITION COLLOQUIUM

Pulitzer Prize winning composer Gunther Schuller returns once again to Eastern, this time to lead a composition colloquium. After presenting his own music and ideas on composition, he will open the floor to discussion of any topic of interest. This is a unique opportunity to interact with a composer and conductor whose mastery of composition and encyclopedic knowledge of the repertoire have earned him a prominent position in the landscape of modern music.

Mr. Schuller's regular visits to Spokane and Eastern Washington University are among the Inland Northwest's most treasured cultural events. Maestro Schuller's long-standing relationship with Eastern and his annual on-campus workshops, open

rehearsals, and master classes provide Eastern's music students and the larger community with unparalleled artistic and educational experiences in friendly and intimate surroundings.

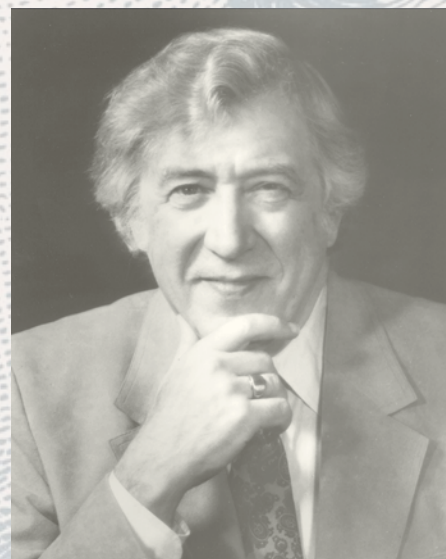
Gunther Schuller has developed a musical career that ranges from composing and conducting to his extensive work as an educator, administrator, music publisher, record producer, and author. His many awards include Guggenheim Fellowships, the Darius Milhaud Award, the Rodgers and Hammerstein Award, and a 1994 Pulitzer Prize in Music for his composition *Reminiscences and Reflections*. His recent publications include *Musings: The Musical Worlds of Gunther Schuller*, a collection of his writings with a foreword by Milton Babbitt.
